

BIIAB Level 2 Award for Personal Licence Holders

This qualification has been designed to allow learners to obtain and then demonstrate the knowledge related to alcohol legislation at Level 2. The achievement of this qualification is a mandatory component for all people wishing to obtain a personal licence to sell alcohol within England and Wales.

COURSE TOPICS:

- The roles, responsibilities and functions of licensing authorities within the framework of the licensing objectives
- The application process for a personal licence
- The role and legal responsibilities of the personal licence holder, and the penalties relating to failure to comply with the law
- The premises licence
- The content and purpose of operating schedules
- The role and duties of the designated premises supervisor (DPS)
- Unauthorised licensable activities

COURSE LENGTH:

The total time for this qualification is 10 hours.

HOW & WHERE IS IT ASSESSED:

This qualification is assessed via multi-choice examination and can be delivered at any approved centre.
