

FAA Level 3 Award in Emergency First Aid at Work (RQF)

Learners will gain the knowledge and practical competence required to deal with a wide range of workplace first aid situations. The qualification is also suitable for people with responsibility for the provision of first aid in other settings such as voluntary and community groups.

COURSE TOPICS:

- Responsibilities and reporting
- Resuscitation and AED awareness
- Burns
- Assessment of the situation
- Anatomy
- Choking
- Dealing with an unresponsive casualty
- Basic hygiene in First Aid
- Bleeding control and Shock

COURSE LENGTH:

A minimum of six contact hours in the classroom, consisting of practical and theoretical activities

HOW & WHERE IS IT ASSESSED:

This qualification is assessed via practical demonstration and will usually be delivered in a classroom environment.
